- Principles of vaccination

- Injection technique
- Consent and working with parents with discussion on potential side effects including anaphylaxis (brief update)

- Legal aspects of vaccination

*Annual **Basic Life Support (BLS)** and **Anaphylaxis** training is expected prior to attending the course.*

A Clinical Supervisor is required back at Practice to observe, support and sign-off the Candidates competency to commence immunisations.
